FAQ...for Pelham Falls Pools

When will the pools open?

- Please see the attached 2025 color-coded calendar for easy reference to dates the pools are open. This includes lap swim times, swim team practices, guarded and unguarded hours for each pool.
- Front pool opens May 2nd and closes September 7th
- Back pool opens May 21st and closes August 10th
- Back pool is unguarded 10a-2p.
- The only unguarded hours are at the front pool during weekdays when school is in session.

How do I gain access to the pools?

- Both pools are accessed via electronic fobs. Fobs are required for entry. Please understand if lifeguards deny entry due to lack of fob.
- Each residence has received one fob free of charge. One additional fob (or replacement for lost/damaged fobs) may be requested at nominal charge from C. Dan Joyner.
- No residence may have more than two active fobs.
- For rental properties, it is not permitted for both owner and renters to have fobs.
- It is not permitted to loan fobs to non-residents or extended family not residing in Pelham Falls.
- Fobs can be inactivated due to abuse or repeated rule violations.

What is adult swim?

- The last ten minutes of each hour are designated as "Adult Swim".
- During this time no one under 18 is allowed in the pool, with the exception of infants in parents' arms.
- Children cannot sit on the steps or ladders during adult swim.

Children at the Pelham Falls Pool

What do I need to know about kids at the pools?

- Children are always welcome with parents or a responsible adult during guarded or unguarded hours.
- During **unguarded** hours, no one under 15 is allowed without a parent or responsible adult.
- Children under 10 are never allowed at the pool without a parent or responsible adult. This applies to guarded and unguarded hours.
- During **guarded** hours, children without parents, between 10 and 15 are allowed in the pool, IF they have passed a swim test with lifeguards.
- Lifeguards or Pool Committee can restrict this access for children in this age range if their behavior or maturity dictates. The lifeguard-on-duty has final say.

What are the swim tests?

Swim tests are required for children between 10 and 15 to attend the pool without adult supervision.

- Tests will be given by lifeguards at scheduled times.
- Schedule for tests will be posted at pool and on website
- Tests are not given "on demand"
- Tests are required for both resident children and their guests.
- The swim test consists of being able to swim across the deep end of the pool unassisted and being able to tread water for 1 minute. Lifeguards can change this requirement as they see fit.
- If a child (or guest) is not on the "passed" list, they will not be allowed in the pool without the presence of a parent or responsible adult.
- When a child enters the pool, he/she will check in with the lifeguard to verify his/her name is on the "Passed" list prior to swimming.

Parties and Guests

What if I want to host a party at one of our pools?

- The cabanas and shelters at the pools are not available for reservation.
- If a party is being held, prior notification to the head lifeguard is required.
- HOA reserves the right to limit or disallow parties on days of peak use.
- Parties over fifteen (children+adults) require hiring an additional lifeguard(s). This is to be scheduled and paid directly to Upstate Pools via their website at www.upstatepoolmanagement.com
- Maximum party size is 30.
- It is not acceptable for multiple residents to combine smaller parties to avoid hiring additional guards.

Can I bring guests to the pools?

- Guests must sign in at the lifeguard shack upon arrival.
- Sign-in includes the name and cell phone number of the responsible parent, if the parent is not present.
- Residents are allowed to bring guests if the pool is not at maximum occupancy.
- Residents are always responsible for the behavior of their guests
- Maximum of 10 guests per family
- Children without a parent present are allowed no more than two guests.
- Guests not signed in properly will be considered trespassing.
- Providing false information to guards is grounds for residents' pool privileges to be revoked or suspended.
- Lifeguards can deny entry to any guests as deemed appropriate at their sole discretion.

What is not allowed at the pool?

- No glass containers are allowed on the pool deck.
- Absolutely no smoking or vaping anywhere in the confines of the pool fencing or on playgrounds.
- No balloons (includes helium and water balloons)
